- 1. By booking a session with us, you are entering into a contract. Changes to the booking are possible, as outlined below, and we will always endeavour to accommodate your wishes. However, due to various factors, it may not always be possible to vary the original booking, especially at short notice.
- 2. Please make sure you inform us if you wish to change the size of your groups, and let us know this as soon as possible. We normally work to an instructor: student ratio of 1:8 (unless otherwise arranged), and we may not be able to change your booking at short notice if this ratio will be compromised, or if we are unable to allocate an extra instructor, or cancel one. Unexpected extra students may not be allowed to climb.
- 3. Ensure that you arrive at least 10 minutes before the start time of your session. Arriving late will shorten your booked session, and a refund will not be possible.
- 4. Bring with you a list of the names, dates of birth (if under 18) and relevant medical conditions of all participants. Please ensure you have obtained parental permissions for the activity.
- 5. The full cost of the course is invoiced / payable when booking.
- 6. The full cost of the invoice must be paid by one week before the date of the session. You may pay by cheque, payable to 'Beacon Climbing Centre Ltd', by BACS sort code 40-16-02 account 91540874, or by card. In each case you will need to quote your invoice number.
- 7. Any booking not paid for within this time scale may be cancelled by us.
- 8. You will be entitled to a refund in the event of a short-notice cancellation of between 48 hours and 7 days, and a 10% handling charge may be levied. No refund will be made for a cancellation within 48 hours of the booking, or a no-show.
